Hylant Administrative Services (HAS) was formed in the fall of 1994 to provide insurance program administration including sales management, marketing, underwriting, policy issuance, claim administration, risk management, accounting, reinsurance placement and administration services. As a member of the Hylant Group of Insurance and Risk Management Companies, HAS has the resources of the 27th largest insurance service organization, as ranked by Business Insurance, available for its operations.

There are currently three public entity programs managed and serviced by HAS. Two are municipality programs (Ohio and Indiana) and one is a public school program.

The Ohio Government Risk Management Plan (Ohio Plan) is a group of approximately 500 political subdivisions with a program premium of over \$12,000,000. The Ohio Plan has been a jointly administered self-insurance and risk management plan since 1988. The Plan is reinsured through well-known national and international reinsurance companies.

The Indiana Municipal Insurance Program was formed to provide property and casualty insurance to Indiana's municipalities. The insurance carrier is Argonaut Insurance Company. The program is designed for counties, cities, towns, townships and other public entities.

The Ohio School Plan (OSP) is jointly administered self-insurance and risk management plan for public schools (K through 12). The OSP was formed in January 2002 and has grown to approximately 400 schools with total premiums of approximately \$12,000,000. This program currently includes casualty (general liability and educational legal liability, including employment practice liability), property, fleet and violence coverage.

Hylant Administrative Services has committed significant resources to develop the services that it provides to the programs it administers. The use of the current technology to provide a more efficient and effective service is a major directive of the group. The goal of HAS is to reduce the time the marketing force needs to spend on administrative items and keep their focus on the customer's needs. HAS has the experience, the resources and the contacts in the insurance and reinsurance industry to provide unique solutions for a variety of program needs.

HAS will only partner with reinsurers with A. M. Best ratings of A- VII or better. (The only exception to this is if the Plan Board of Directors specifies different requirements.)
